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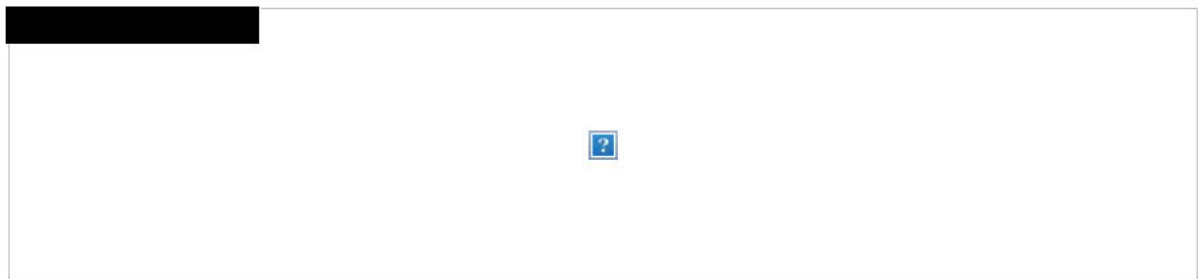

## **LGBT Youth Scotland (SC024047) – opening inquiry letter**

I am writing to you as the primary contact of the above charity, further to our previous discussions and correspondence. Please share the contents of this letter with the trustees of the charity at the earliest opportunity.

The purpose of this letter is to notify the charity trustees that we are taking forward some matters of concern with the charity using our powers of inquiry under section 28 of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 (the 2005 Act). Information available to OSCR, including your emails to me of 11 December 2024 have been considered in accordance with our guidance '[How OSCR deals with concerns and inquiries](#)'. The guidance provides information regarding the regulatory framework that OSCR operates under and the supervisory powers available to us.

### **The matters of concern**

The concerns we have are broadly those that we discussed when we met on 21 November and about which you responded to us following your Board's meeting on 7 December 2024. We note and appreciate the charity's proactive engagement with us on these issues, but we continue to be concerned in the

light of the responses that you have provided to us on behalf of the charity. The points at issue are:

## **1. Whether the charity is operating within its objects**

The charity's objects as stated in its articles of association as adopted on 27 February 2021 are as follows:

*The Objects shall be to promote the benefit, to preserve and protect the physical, mental and spiritual good health, and to advance the education of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender young people between the ages of 13 and 25 within the area of benefit; by working towards the elimination of discrimination against, and to promote equality of opportunity for all lesbian, gay bisexual and transgender young people with a view to enabling them to participate fully in the social, economic and civic life of their communities.*

We understand that the charity has been providing educational material and training to staff in primary schools. On the face of it, this appears to call into question whether the charity is operating within its objects, since primary school pupils fall below age range set out as the charity's beneficiary group in the charity's objects.

I note from your email of 11 December 2024 that the charity trustees have discussed 'our objects, the programmes we deliver as part of this and how our objects should reflect the programmes we undertake both now and in the future', [REDACTED]

While I am glad to note the intention to resolve the issue, the charity trustees should note that we expect them to do so as a matter of urgency. As set out below, one of the key duties of a charity trustee is to ensure the charity operates consistently with its purposes. Failure to do this is a breach of duty and, potentially, constitutes misconduct under the 2005 Act.

OSCR provides [guidance to the sector on how to draft charitable purposes](#), and trustees may find it helpful to consider this guidance in the course of their discussions.

## 2. The charity's engagement and public statements on the findings of the Cass Review and consequent developments in Scotland

We note that the news statement on the pause in referrals from the Sandyford Clinic to Paediatric Endocrinology originally posted in April 2024 is still on the website at the time of writing (<https://lgbtyouth.org.uk/news-statement-april-2024/>). We note that the second part of the text is a statement on behalf of the charity's Trans Rights Youth Commission. It expresses disagreement with key findings of the Independent Review of Gender Identity Services for Children and Young People ('the Cass Review') and the pause in referrals.

I should also stress the need for the charity, as one set up to advance the education of its beneficiary group, to meet the requirements of providing public benefit under this charitable purpose. In particular, charity trustees should note the following part of OSCR's [guidance](#):

*Where a charity is providing education in respect of controversial issues it must do so in a way that allows the people being educated to make up their own minds. In such cases, a charity should present information in a neutral and balanced way. If it reaches conclusions, they should be based on evidence, analysis and reasoning. Raising awareness about an issue to gain support for a campaign does not advance education, though it may be a way of furthering other charitable purposes.*

The charity trustees should also consider this guidance in their consideration of the charity's objects and whether its activities are consistent with those. Our [guidance on writing charitable purposes](#) may also be helpful.

## **The basis for our inquiries**

Our inquiries are made under Section 28 of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 (the 2005 Act) and are conducted in order to assist our understanding of the matters of concern. Opening an inquiry does not mean that we infer any wrongdoing on the part of the charity or the charity trustees. We will not reach any conclusions until we are satisfied that we have established the facts, and the charity trustees have had an opportunity to explain any actions they have taken.

This inquiry is confidential. With the exception of professional advisors, such as lawyers or accountants, OSCR expects that you do not share the fact of this letter, its terms or any response you provide with any third parties. In addition, I would note that any request for information under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 covering information gathered by us in the course of an inquiry would be considered in light of the appropriate exemptions relevant to formal inquiry activity.

## OSCR's regulatory interest

Under the 2005 Act, the charity trustees have general control and management of the administration of the charity. Section 66 of the 2005 Act places the charity trustees under a number of general duties. They must:

1. Act in the interests of the charity and must, in particular: –
  - seek, in good faith, to ensure that the charity acts in a manner which is consistent with its purposes;
  - act with the care and diligence that it is reasonable to expect of a person who is managing the affairs of another person; and
  - manage any conflict of interest between the charity and any person or organisation responsible for the appointment of the charity trustee.
2. Ensure that the charity complies with any direction, requirement, notice or duty imposed on it in terms of the 2005 Act ('the specific duties').

As a body, the charity trustees have a collective responsibility to act in the interest of the charity and comply with the specific duties. Any breach of these duties is to be treated as misconduct in the administration of the charity ('misconduct' includes mismanagement).

Our '[Guidance and good practice for Charity Trustees](#)' publication provides further information on charity trustee duties and the specific duties in the 2005 Act. We recommend that all charity trustees read this guidance.

### Next Steps

In your 11 December 2024 email you indicated that the charity trustees would be willing to meet to discuss these issues. This is a helpful offer and in light of the complexity of these issues I think such a meeting would be the best way forward. It might be most helpful if we could meet before the meeting of the charity's board at which the issues around its objects are due to be discussed, so that this discussion can be fully informed by our considerations on the issues involved.

Dear Trustees

We write to advise you that following information made available to OSCR, we have some concerns about the above charity that need to be brought to the attention of the charity trustees. **Please ensure that all charity trustees are aware of this communication.**

The concerns we have relate to a safeguarding issue within the charity, particularly around the advice given to young people who are self-harming.

Under the 2005 Act, you as charity trustees are responsible for the general control and management of the administration of the charity. Section 66 of the 2005 Act places the charity trustees under a number of general duties. You must act in the interests of the charity and must, in particular:-

- seek, in good faith, to ensure that the charity acts in a manner which is consistent with its purposes;
- act with the care and diligence that it is reasonable to expect of a person who is managing the affairs of another person; and
- manage any conflict of interest between the charity and any person or organisation responsible for the appointment of the charity trustee.

The charity trustees must ensure they are aware of the sensitivities around how they advise volunteers to help those who are self-harming and to the individuals themselves who are self-harming. The charity trustees must ensure they are not being seen to be approving or encouraging this behaviour but rather should ensure they are recommending that the individual seeks professional help from suitably qualified medial staff.

OSCR has produced its own safeguarding guidance which we would encourage all the charity trustees to read - [OSCR | Safeguarding Guidance: Keeping vulnerable beneficiaries safe](#).

For now, we are merely bringing these allegations to the attention of the charity trustees and we expect you to consider the issues, take appropriate

advice if necessary, and ensure yourselves that you are complying with your legal duties as charity trustees. If any further concerns are received, we will consider whether it is appropriate to open an inquiry into the charity.

[REDACTED] Please can you provide an update of the progress of the [REDACTED] and also when can we expect to receive the boards response?

In addition to the above, OSCR has further information we would like to share with the board. We have been made aware that the charity is carrying our educational activities in primary schools. The objects as set out in the charity's Articles of Association at clause 5 state:

"to promote the benefit, to preserve and protect the physical, mental and spiritual good health, and to advance the education of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender young people between the ages of 13 and 25 within the area of benefit; by working towards the elimination of discrimination against, and to promote equality of opportunity for all lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender young people with a view to enabling them to participate fully in the social, economic and civic life of their communities."

The above specifies that young people between the ages of 13 and 25 will benefit from the activities of the charity therefore if the charity is now undertaking activity of any sort in primary schools, then the objects clause above will need to be amended to reflect this. Prior consent from OSCR must be sought in order to make changes to the objects; the application form can be found here – [OSCR | Change your charity's purpose\(s\)](#).
